

Welcome to our 100 club

Join our 100 club today and you could be our next winner!

The 100 club is a great way for you to support our Community Library and win cash prizes! Here's how it works...

The 100 club is open to all members of the public, aged 16yrs and over.

The lottery costs £2 a month per number, (to be paid as a 12-month subscription of £24 per number, or pro-rata if you join mid-year). The annual membership runs from November to October, the following year. Numbers will be randomly allocated, and you may buy more than one number, just let us know on the attached form.

Don't worry if you miss the initial sign up in October, you can join the 100 club at any time, if numbers are available. Your numbers will be entered into the next available draw once your payment has been received (see our rules for further information).

To join the scheme please complete, sign and return the attached membership form to the Library. You can make your payment by bank transfer (BACS - details below) OR pay by cash/card at the Library.

Once we receive your payment you will be given a Membership card with your membership number and your allocated 100 club number/s. You will be entered into the next monthly draw (the first Wednesday of each month), for the remainder of the current 12-month membership period.

If you win, you will be contacted direct and cash prizes will be available to collect from the Library, during opening hours. You will need to show your membership card to collect your prize (if lost please request a new one).

The prize money will be 40% of the total monthly subscription fees (1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes). The remaining 60% goes to the Library funds.

100 club rules

Purpose

The purpose of the 100 club is to raise funds to help ensure the future of the Library, which relies entirely on raising funds to stay open. The money will be paid into the Library bank account and used to meet the running cost of the Library and any projects as agreed by the Trustees.

Rules

- 1. The 100 club is a Small Society Lottery, registered with South Tyneside Council (LN/00007678). It is open to all, anyone aged 16 or over can join.
- 2. A draw will be made, on the first Wednesday of the month with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize (in the event of any Bank Holidays falling on this date, the draw will be made the following week).
- 3. The prizes will total 40% of the monthly subscription fees. This will be apportioned as: 1st prize of 60%, 2nd prize of 30% and 3rd prize of 10%.
- 4. The 12-month subscription/membership runs from November October annually. Subscription feed must be received by the **Friday of the 2**nd **week in October**, to be entered into the November draw.
- 5. For mid-year subscriptions, payments must be received by the **3**rd **Friday of the month**, before numbers can be entered into the following months draw. If received after that date, numbers will be entered into the next available lottery.
- 6. Payments can be made by bank transfer (BACS) or cash/card payments during Library opening hours.
- 7. No refunds are available once payment has been made.
- 8. Membership renewals will be sent out once a year in September, it is the members responsibility to keep their subscription up to date. The Library is not able to send out monthly reminders.
- 9. Please note if membership fees are not paid on time and your membership lapses, you may rejoin but you cannot be guaranteed the same numbers.
- 10. The winning member will be advised, and cash prizes will be available for collection from the library during opening hours. You will need your Membership card to collect your winnings.
- 11. The winning numbers for each month's winners will be displayed in the Library, posted on the Library website and on the Library facebook page.
- 12. The 100 club will be run by the Boldon and Cleadon Community Library Trustees. In case of any dispute the decision of the Trustees is final.
- 13. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 club if his/her subscription renewal is not paid on time I.e. the 2nd Friday in October for annual memberships. For those who initially joined part-way through the year they must renew the following October to retain the same numbers.
- 14. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into Library funds after a period of six months from the date of the draw.
